REFUND POLICY

- In common with other educational institutions, all fees are non-refundable unless a course is cancelled by Health Institute Australasia. The application fee of \$250.00 is non-refundable.
- Health Institute Australasia reserves the right to cancel or postpone any courses prior to their scheduled commencement date. In such circumstances, if a course is cancelled, or postponed by more than four weeks, and if the student is unable or unwilling to enrol in a similar course at Health Institute Australasia, all fees will be refunded within two weeks after the default day, less enrolment fee of \$250.
- There is no reduction in tuition fees for students who commence late. No refund or extension of time applies.
- Enrolment fees must accompany your enrolment form for us to process it.
- All fees are non-transferable. Any credit of fees held is for the use of that student only.
- Students will be responsible for their own (i) Equipment (ii) Professional Association Membership (iii)
 Transport (v) Accommodation (iv) Meals and (vi) Insurance.
- All fees are subject to change, generally per course or on an annual basis. You must confirm current fees before enrolment or re-enrolment.
- Current and revised fees will apply to all unpaid fees.
- 200 fee applies for practical exam. Re-sit \$200.
- Refunds will only be considered where a valid receipt is provided, that has been issued by Health Institute Australasia or an authorised Education Agent.



REFUND POLICY, continued

- · On receiving a written application for course refund, the Enrolments Officer shall: -
- 1. Provide a total refund of tuition fees paid in advance where a course place is no longer available or a Visa has been denied.
- 2. Provide an 85% refund of tuition fees paid in advance, where enrolling students provide more than 10 weeks written notice of their intention to withdraw from the course prior to commencement of the course. The partial refund will be less 10% administration fee.
- 3. Provide a 75% refund of tuition fees paid in advance, where enrolling students provide more than 4 week's and up to 10 week's written notice of their intention to withdraw from the course prior to course commencement. The partial refund will be less 25% of tuition fees. The partial refund will be less 10% administration fee.
- 4. Provide no refund of tuition fees paid in advance, where enrolling students provide less than 4 weeks written notice of their intention to withdraw from the course prior to course commencement.
- 5. No refund will be paid after the agreed start date, and after the course has commenced. Refunds will only be paid to the person who has entered into the contract with Health Institute Australasia, unless the person requests in a signed statement, that payment of the refund be made to a third party. Refunds will be paid within four weeks of receipt of written notification. Bank charges/IMT fees will be deducted from any refund made by electronic transfer.
- If your visa application is denied by Immigration, the enrolment fee and any material or text book fees
 will not be refunded. Students who dispute the refund procedures will be provided with access to Health
 Institute Australasia's internal/external appeals procedure and be advised of their further rights under
 civil consumer protection laws.
- No refunds or deferments of time or payment are given for failure to attend in fixed schedule courses.
- In accordance with the national code of Practice for Registration Authorities and Providers of Educational and Training to Overseas Students 2007, International students must stay with Health Institute Australasia the first 6 months of their principal course.
- Health Institute Australasia will not release students to a provider that is not CRICOS registered.
 Refunds, if eligible, will be paid 30 days after HIA provides the letter of release.

NOTE: If a learner does not communicate with HIA, in a timely manner (before the due date) regarding late homework or late payments, they risk being entered as withdrawn from the course, past their course end date. As some of the courses are assessed holistically, neither can there be any statement of attainment issued in lieu of the qualification.
